FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the game control console shown in FIG. 1.

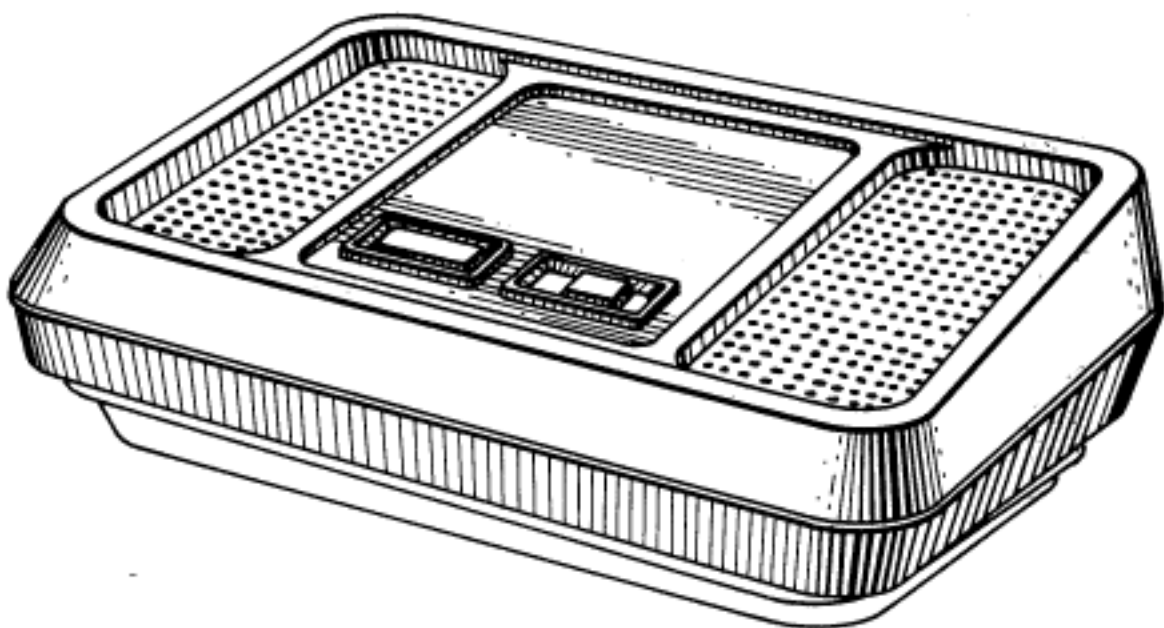
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the game control console shown in FIG. 1.

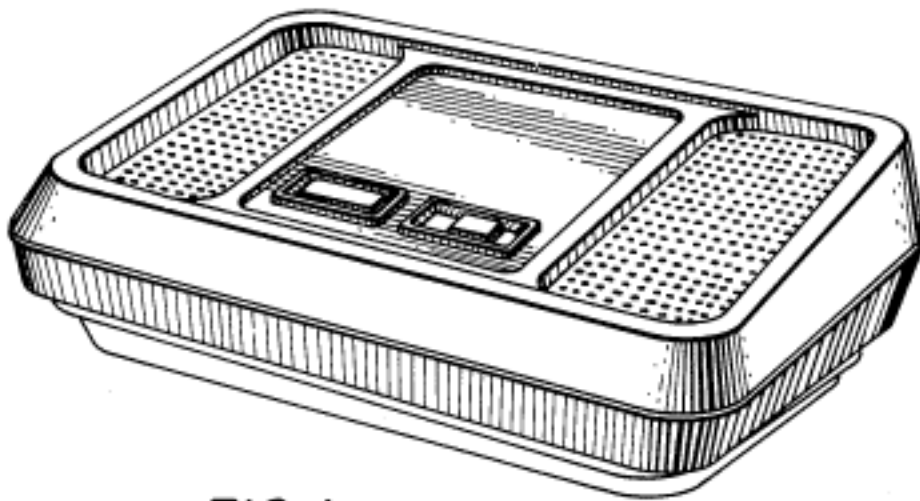
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the game control console shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the game control console shown in FIG. 1.

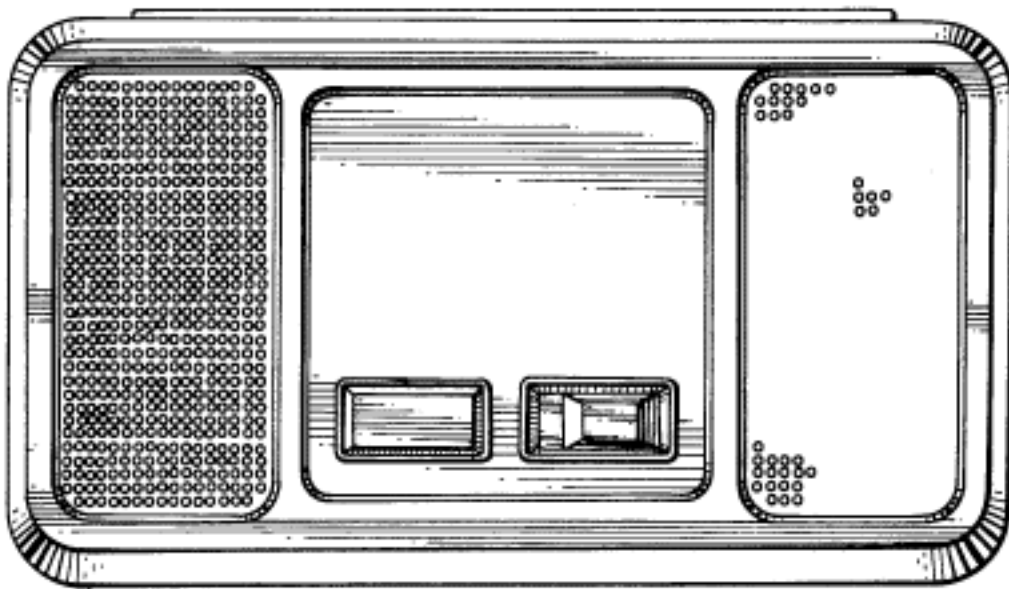
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the game control console shown in FIG. 1.

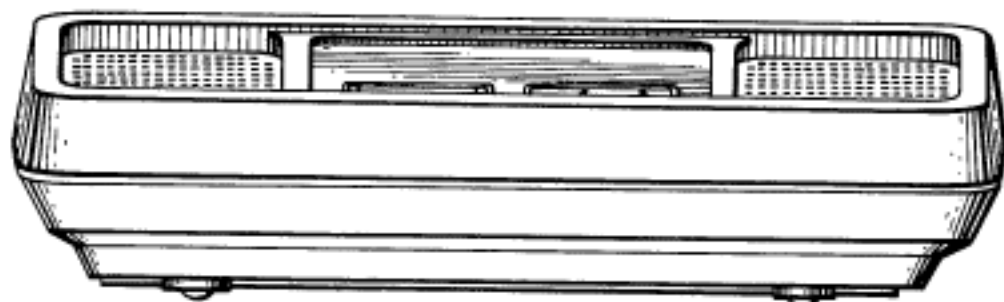

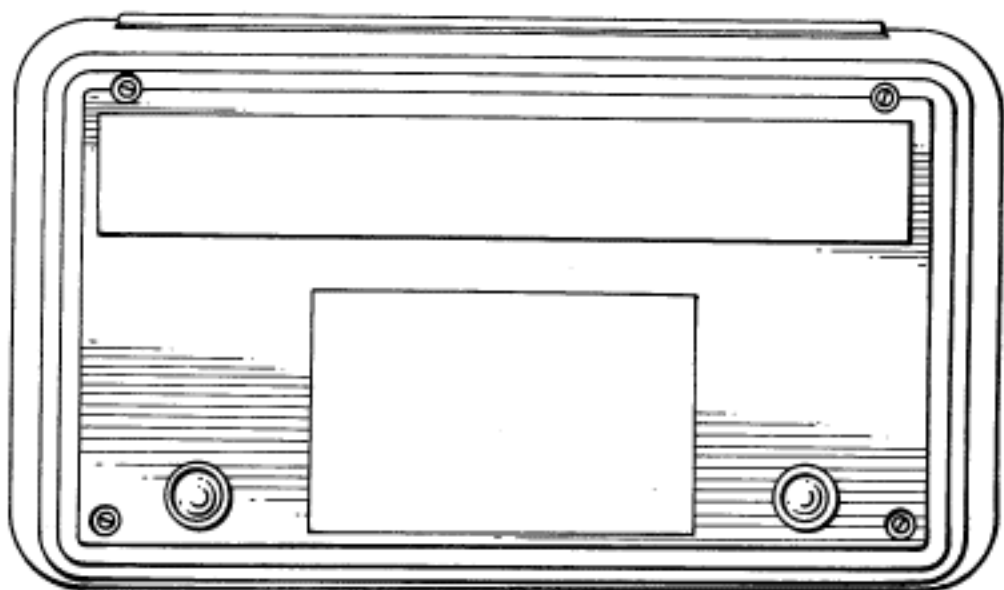

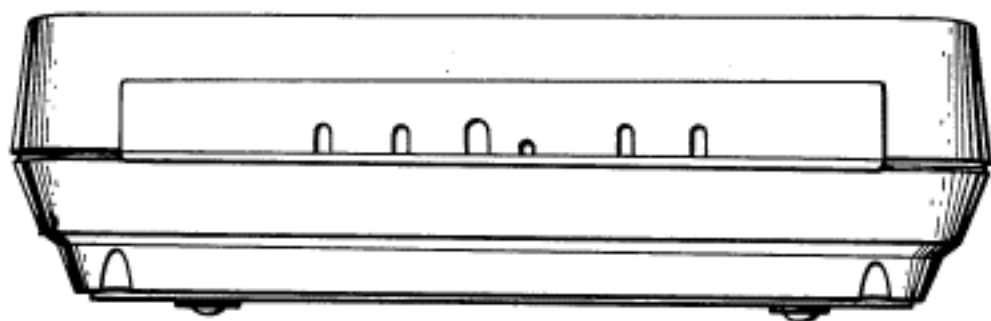
